




**Dear Zendo Community,**





### Outcomes

- Peer-based care reduces emergency interventions and builds collaboration between patrons, harm reduction staff, and professional safety teams.
- Partnership with Stadium Medical demonstrates that embedding harm reduction within existing medical infrastructure improves outcomes while reducing costs.
- Research framework positions Zendo Projects's approach as replicable and evidence-informed, supporting broader adoption.

## 2025 Groundbreaking Initiatives

### Crisis Response

- In collaboration with the Cohen Foundation, Zendo Project aims to transform mental health crisis response nationwide.
- Our pilot program, Emergency Psychological Response (EPR) for Crisis Teams, launches January '26.
- In 2026, we begin EPR development for diverse settings:
  - Healthcare Systems
  - Public Safety
  - Education Systems
  - Communities

### Zendo Lab

- Our new research arm brings peer support principles into psychedelic science and crisis response research—uniting data integrity with field-based learning.
- Already gaining national recognition, including presentation at APHA.
- In 2026, we begin building datasets on emergency psychological response training outcomes and psychedelic harm reduction.
